Healing and Salvation

The readings today speak of healing and salvation. In Second Kings, Naaman, a commander of the army of the king of Syria, develops leprosy. He goes to a stranger, a prophet from Israel, when no one else can cure his disease. Much to his surprise, after a simple bath in the river, he is cured. In Luke’s Gospel, Jesus cures ten lepers and sends them to the priest. Only one, a Samaritan, returns to thank Jesus for his cure and only he hears the words, “Your faith has saved you.” The psalm and Timothy remind us that salvation involves justice, kindness, and faithfulness and forever links us with Jesus. In a world as broken as ours, both healing and salvation are necessary.

Psalm – “The Lord has revealed to the nations his saving power” (Psal 98).
Second Reading – If we have died with Christ we shall also live with Christ (2 Tim 2:8-13).
Gospel – Ten lepers are healed by Jesus, but only one, a Samaritan, returns to give thanks (Lk 17:11-19).

Acude a un extraño, un profeta de Israel, cuando nadie más puede curar su enfermedad. Para su sorpresa, tras un simple baño en el río, se cura. En el Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús cura a diez leprosos y los envía al sacerdote. Solo uno, un samaritano, regresa para agradecerle a Jesús su curación y solo él escucha las palabras: “Tu fe te ha salvado”. El salmo y Timoteo nos recuerdan que la salvación implica justicia, bondad y fidelidad, y nos vincula para siempre con Jesús. En un mundo tan quebrantado como el nuestro, tanto la sanación como la salvación son necesarias.

Domingo Mundial de las Misiones - 19 de octubre

El próximo domingo 19 de octubre, nuestra segunda colecta se dedicará al Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. Su generosidad brindará esperanza donde la desesperación a menudo domina, mediante la construcción de iglesias, la formación de seminaristas y religiosas, centros de salud y escuelas católicas.
