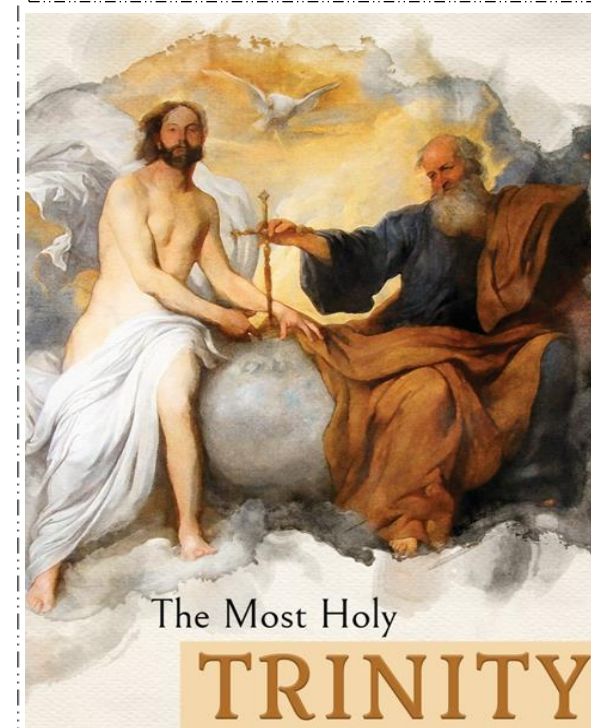

Living in Communion with the Triune God



The implications of the Trinity for our Christian faith and life are manifold and significant. First and foremost, the Trinity reveals that God is a God of relationship, love, and community. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are distinct persons who share the

same divine essence, united in an eternal bond of love and mutual self-giving. This means that God is not a solitary being or a distant deity but a personal and relational God who invites us to enter into a loving communion with Him.

Moreover, the Trinity reveals that we are created in the image and likeness of God, as beings who are meant to live in relationships of love and communion with others. We are called to imitate the triune God by loving one another as He has loved us, by sharing our lives and resources with those in need, by forgiving one another as we have been forgiven, and by building communities of faith, hope, and charity.

The readings for Trinity Sunday Year A also remind us that our salvation is a gift of God's love and grace, not something we can earn or deserve by our own merits. The Father sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem us from sin and death and to reconcile us with Him. The Son, by His death and resurrection, made it possible for us to share in His divine life and to become children of God. The Holy Spirit, poured out on us in Baptism and Confirmation, empowers us to live as faithful disciples of Christ and to bear witness to His gospel in the world. — Young Catholics
